Only ACBS qualified boats are accepted: wood and fiberglass boats manufactured prior to 1976 or replicas thereof. Each boat in the Field of Dreams area must have a "FOR SALE" sign provided by the Field of Dreams manager (see Registration Desk at the Festival), which will include the specifics of that boat. Pre-registration is not required, but desired, to guarantee a slot. You may show up at the festival at any time Friday or Saturday and enter your boat in the Field of Dreams, assuming a slot exists. Costs are the same regardless of the entry time.
