Each boat in the Field of Dreams area must have a "FOR SALE" sign provided by the Field of Dreams manager (see Registration Desk at the Festival), which will include the specifics of that boat. Pre-registration is not required, but desired, to guarantee a slot. You may show up at the festival at any time during show hours on Friday or Saturday and enter your boat in the Field of Dreams, assuming a slot exists. Costs are the same regardless of the entry time.
